Any person aggrieved by the making of the Spratton Neighbourhood Plan may only make an application to the High Court under Section 61N of the 2011 Localism Act as applied to Neighbourhood Plans by Section 38C (2) (d) of the 2004 Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004.

Any such application must be made no later than the end of the period of six weeks starting from the date the Spratton Neighbourhood Development Plan was made on 22 July 2016.
