Anglian Water	Support	<p>Support policy BO-G1 that states SuDs should be included in new developments wherever possible as all developments should seek to reduce flood risk and incorporate Sustainable Drainage Systems.</p> <p>Support policy BO-D1 that states the use of SuDS should form part of the design of new developments as all developments should seek to reduce flood risk and incorporate Sustainable Drainage Systems.</p> <p>Support policy BO-D3 that states new development should incorporate SuDS to minimize surface water run-off as all developments should seek to reduce flood risk and incorporate Sustainable Drainage Systems.</p>
DDC Officer Response	Comment	<p>Criterion (h) of policy BO-GP1 should include 'wherever possible' at the end of the sentence to allow for flexibility and ensure that any development will be viable and deliverable.</p> <p>Criterion (k) of policy BO-D1 should be deleted as this criterion is addressed in a policy of its own – policy BO-D3.</p> <p>Suggest a modification to the plan to include a separate map to show local green space on an OS base map to provide clarity in decision making.</p>
