### Crick Village Neighbourhood Development Plan- Notice of Making of Plan

Notice is hereby given under Schedule 38A (9) of the Localism Act 2011 and Regulation 19 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (as amended) that Daventry District Council made the Crick Village Neighbourhood Development Plan on 26<sup>th</sup> January 2018.

The Neighbourhood Plan now forms part of the statutory Development Plan for Daventry District and will be used by the District Council to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area.

Any person aggrieved by the making of the Crick Village Neighbourhood Plan may only make an application to the High Court under Section 61N of the 2011 Localism Act as applied to Neighbourhood Plans by Section 38C (2) (d) of the 2004 Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004.

Any such application must be made no later than the end of the period of six weeks starting from the date the Crick Village Neighbourhood Development Plan was made on 26<sup>th</sup> January 2018.
