

When visiting for a Knowledge Test from 1st January 2018 onwards, you will be required to show us your Current Valid UK (or Equivalent) Driving Licence and document(s) to confirm your eligibility to live and work in the UK. The only documents we will accept as proof of your right to live and work in the UK are:

- A Current Biometric Immigration Document (Biometric Residence Permit) issued by the Home Office to the holder indicating that the person named is allowed to stay indefinitely in the UK, or has no time limit on their stay in the UK. or
- A Current Biometric Immigration Document (Biometric Residence Permit) issued by the Home Office to the holder which indicates that the named person can currently stay in the UK and is allowed to do taxi/private hire work. or
- A Current Passport endorsed to show that the holder is exempt from Immigration Control, is allowed to stay indefinitely in the UK, has the right of abode in the UK, or has no time limit on their stay in the UK. (Valid Passport issued in any country) or
- A Current Passport endorsed to show that the holder is allowed to stay in the UK and is currently allowed to do taxi/private hire work. (Valid Passport issued in any country) or
- A Certificate of Application issued by the Home office under regulation 17(3) or 18A (2) of the Immigration (European Economic Area) Regulations 2006, to a family member of a European Economic Area country or Switzerland stating that the holder is permitted to take employment which is less than 6 months old together with a Positive Verification Notice from the Home Office Employer Checking Service. or
- A Current Valid Passport (issued in any Country) along with A Current Residence Card (including an Accession Residence Card or a Derivative Residence Card) issued by the Home Office to a non-European Economic Area national who is a family member of a national of a European Economic Area Country or Switzerland or who has a derivative right of residence. or
- A Current Valid Passport (issued in any Country) along with a Current Immigration Status Document containing a Photograph issued by the Home Office to the holder with a valid endorsement indicating that the named person may stay in the UK, and is allowed to do taxi or private hire work, together with an official document giving the person's permanent National Insurance number and their name issued by the Government Agency or a previous employer. or
- A Current Valid Passport (issued in any Country) along with a Current Immigration Status Document issued by the Home Office to the holder with an endorsement indicating that the named person is allowed to stay indefinitely in the UK or has no time limit on their stay in the UK, together with an official document giving the person's permanent National Insurance Number and their name issued by a Government agency or a previous employer.

Failure to provide these documents prior to the test will result in you being unable to take the test on that date, and having to rebook and pay an additional £40 to be booked on a test at a later date.
