Title of the Plan

Settlements and Countryside Local Plan (Part 2) for Daventry District.

Subject Matter and area covered by the Plan

Daventry District Council has published the Part 2 Local Plan that it intends to submit to the Secretary of State for independent examination. The Local Plan will cover the whole of the administrative area of Daventry District and includes a wide range of planning policies which will supplement and in one case replace a policy in the West Northamptonshire Joint Core Strategy Local Plan (Part 1).

The Part 2 Local Plan sets out a vision, objectives and spatial strategy to 2029 following the strategy established in the Part 1 Local Plan. The Local Plan allocates sites that are needed to accommodate new development and areas to be protected and enhanced. The policies in the Plan will be used, alongside the Part 1 Plan and made Neighbourhood Plans to make decisions on planning applications. The monitoring framework sets out how the Plan will be monitored.

Period for making representations

Representations are invited on the Proposed Submission Local Plan for a period of seven weeks and four days which begins on Monday 13th August and ends at **4.30pm on Friday 5th October 2018.**

Representations received after this time will not be accepted. Only representations received within this period have a statutory right to be considered by the Inspector at the Examination.
