I believe that placing Staverton in the Secondary Service Village section was NOT SOUND for the following reasons. I have lived in Staverton for 43 years. In that time we have lost our post office, we have lost our shop. There was a farm shop for a while but that was closed to make the farm a wedding venue instead in August 2017. We used to have weekday bus service to Daventry, but now there is one bus a day to Leamington and back and no return service at all to Daventry. We do have ONE playing field that has mostly children's swings and a small section at the end for the children to play football. We DO NOT have two playing fields as described in our scoring. We also have a very full primary school, with over 90% of the pupils coming by car each day from Daventry. On Tuesday 5th September, I attended a Parish Council meeting as a village member of the public. When the subject of the Settlement Policy came up, there was genuine shock and disbelief that the letter that had gone to DDC claimed that the PC was "NOT OF A MIND..." to request a change from Secondary Service to OTHER. Due to the universal view that this did not accurately reflect their belief that Staverton properly should be in the OTHER category, it was unanimously resolved to write a letter to DDC, asking that Staverton be placed in its correct category - namely OTHER, where all future development should be of "small scale, fully appropriate and sympatheticallt delivered". I fully support sympathetic growth and feel that the current category decision is VERY UNSOUND.
