The parish of Staverton has been placed in the wrong Hierarchy Category. This is an unsound action.

With regard to the current consultation being undertaken by DDC on the Settlements & Countryside Local Plan Part 2, Staverton Parish Council would like to submit a revised statement.

Following the September meeting of Staverton Parish Council, it was proposed, and unanimously agreed, that SPC were in error in their previous submission where they stated that "we were not of a mind as to which settlement Staverton falls in".

The council have agreed that they should submit a correction to this previous submission which included the above statement. We therefore request that it be replaced with:

" We are firmly of the belief that the parish of Staverton falls well within the category of 'other villages' and is therefore currently in the wrong category, both on the Numerical and Reflective bases.

We are disappointed to see that we have still been awarded points for:

- A shop / take-away which, as was pointed out in our previous submission, does not exist.
- A daily bus service which neither runs daily nor provides a return service to Daventry (first bus 18:31).
- DDC has also awarded a point for having a Playing Ground and an additional point for a Sports Ground. In actual fact, they are one and the same being a single parcel of land for multiple leisure use."

Therefore, using Daventry District Councils own allocation marking system, we are of the firm belief that Staverton Parish should not be classified as a 'secondary service village' and should be reassigned to 'other village' status.
