The concern of Badby Parish Neighbourhood Plan Group relates the DDC "Settlement Hierarchy Background Paper Version 2 –July 2018". There is an implication in paragraph 3.8 (Neighbourhood Development Plans) that our plan supports the Secondary Service Village classification because the term is mentioned. The plan does not do this, indeed paragraph 5.2.4 of the Neighbourhood Plan states *"Under the emerging DDC Settlements and Countryside Plan Part 2A a new hierarchy of settlements is being proposed. This currently classifies Badby as a Secondary Service Village, a classification that Badby Parish council has concerns about and has submitted alternative arguments in response to the consultation on the Draft Plan"* Our original objections submitted as representations to the Emerging Draft Local Plan still hold good and should be referred to. Thus our clear position is that Badby should be categorised as "Other Village" in the settlement hierarchy. Furthermore we believe that the table in 3.8 of the DDC "Settlement Hierarchy Background Paper Version 2 –July 2018" is unsound as several of the NPs were "made" before the draft Local Plan and its proposed hierarchy of settlements, so these could not possibly comment on the hierarchy.

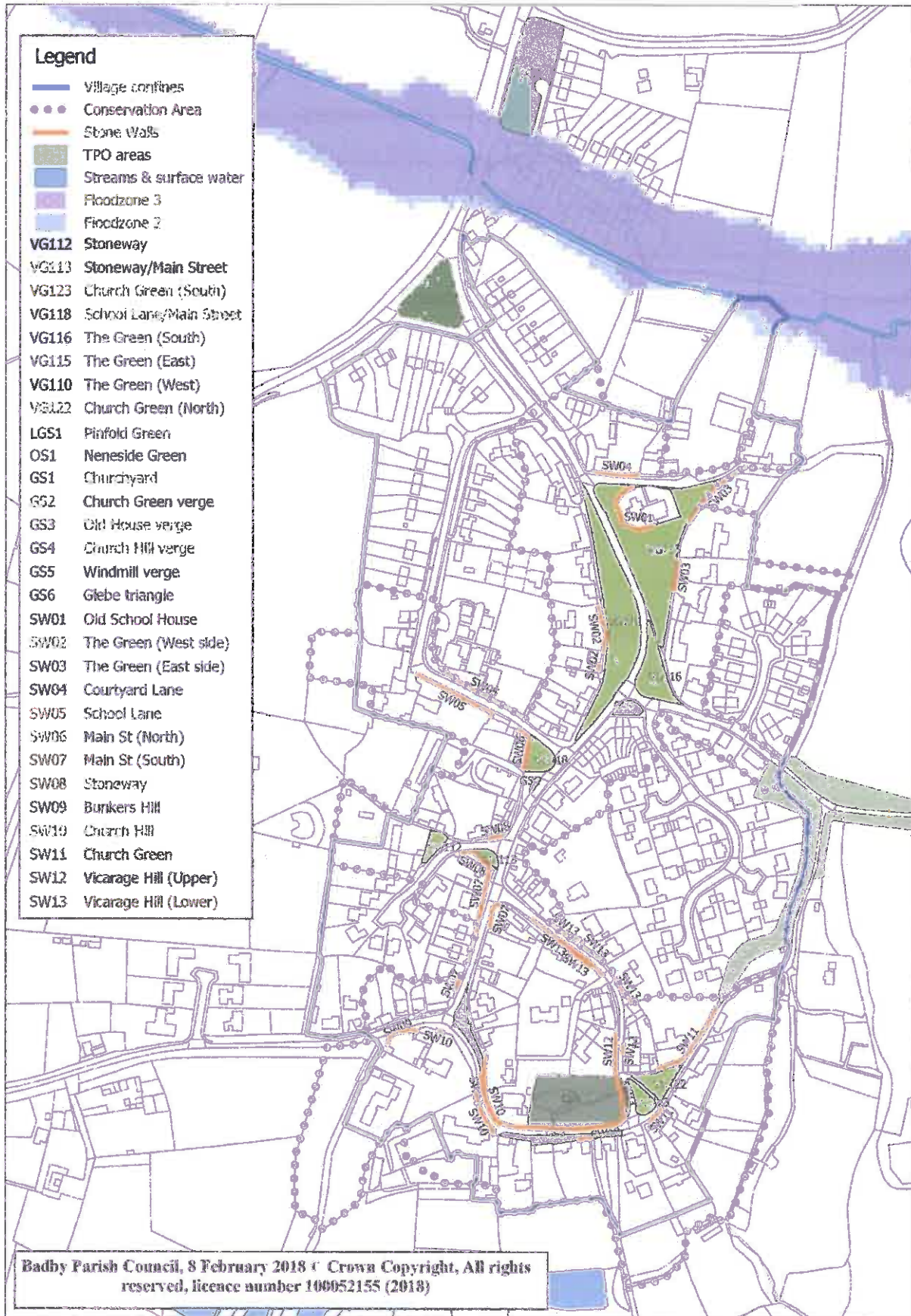
