CPRE West Northants commented in some detail upon the Northampton Northern Orbital Route and Northampton North West Relief Road at the latest consultation stage held in the summer of 2017.

It is considered the comments made in this plan at 8.3 to be unsound [indeed inappropriate] ... in that in this plan a substantive view should be made as to the 'preferences' particularly in the circumstances of the comments re 8.3.03.

The consequences for villages and communities in the vicinity of these road proposals clearly should be provided with some indications of the District's likely preferred options and the implications thereof.

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CPRE West Northants in principle agree with the provisions of 9.1.10 but fundamentally disagree with the provisions 9.1.11 in that we suggest justification exists for retaining all SLA.s scheduled in the 'Saved Local Plan Policy EN10'.

In particular we note having regard to the provisions of this plan, Chapter 3 : Visions and Objectives '... villages will retain their local distinctiveness and character set within a beautiful landscape'.

And indeed ... there are very many other references in this plan to protecting 'landscape character', seemingly at odds with the proposed reduction of SLA.s !

Most certainly the Brampton Valley should be included as a Special Landscape Area in this plan ... a particular concern is that Brixworth has been developed near to its possible limits to the east and south and may now be subject to serious and sustained pressures to develop further north and west extending into and to the detriment of the unique rural landscape of the Brampton Valley.

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In this plan, 9.1.12 should be amended ... and the list of SLA.s duly increased to ensure all possible 'protections' can be afforded as regards the unique rural landscapes' within the Daventry District Area. .

Inclusion of the Brampton Valley in particular as a SLA is deemed an absolute imperative.

It is a serious concern that notwithstanding the unique landscape character of very much of the county ... within Northamptonshire there are no national statutory designations as such.
