Subject Matter

Daventry District Council submitted the Settlements and Countryside Local Plan (Part 2) for Daventry District to the Secretary of State in December 2018 for examination. Examination Hearings were held by the Planning Inspector Gareth Wildgoose BSc (Hons) MSc MRTPI in June 2019.

Following the Hearings, a number of Main Modifications have been prepared at the request of the Planning Inspector. A Main Modification is an amendment which is considered necessary to make the Plan sound and is required in order to address concerns raised by the Inspector or other representors during the examination process. The Council has prepared a schedule setting out the proposed Main Modifications and associated policy map changes it considers necessary in order for the Local Plan to be found sound. They are put forward without prejudice to the Inspector's final conclusions and all representations will be taken into account by the Inspector. The Main Modifications have been subject to Sustainability Appraisal and Habitats Regulations Assessment. Representations to the Main Modifications, Sustainability Appraisal and Habitats Regulations Assessment will be forwarded to the Inspector.

The Council is also consulting on Additional Modifications and associated policy map changes which are minor changes that do not relate to the Plan's soundness. The Inspector will not be considering these in his report and recommendations; responses will be a matter for the Council to consider.

Period for making representations

The consultation runs for six weeks from Monday 23rd September 2019 to 5pm on Monday 4th November 2019. Representations must arrive no later than 5pm on Monday 4th November 2019.
