In accordance with Regulations 26 and 35 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended), notice is hereby given that the Settlements and Countryside Local Plan (Part 2) for Daventry District 2011-2029, a development plan document (DPD), was formally adopted by Daventry District Council on 20 February 2020.

The Settlements and Countryside Local Plan (Part 2) for Daventry District 2011-2029 replaces all of the saved policies of the Daventry District Local Plan 1991-2006 (adopted in 1997) and supersedes Policy H6 of the West Northamptonshire Joint Core Strategy 2011-2029 (adopted in 2014).

The Settlements and Countryside Local Plan (Part 2) for Daventry District was subject to examination by an independent inspector appointed by the Secretary of State, Gareth Wildgoose BSc (Hons) MSc MRTPI, who issued his report on 10 January 2020. The report concluded that, subject to Main Modifications, the Local Plan satisfies the requirements of Section 20(5) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 and meets the criteria for soundness in the NPPF. The adopted, final version of the Local Plan contains all the Main Modifications recommended by the Inspector.

Paper copies are available for inspection during normal opening hours, at the locations listed overleaf.

Any person aggrieved by the Settlements and Countryside Local Plan (Part 2) for Daventry District 2011-2029 may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the

Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that the Local Plan is not within the appropriate powers conferred by Part 2 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act and/or a procedural requirement has not been complied with. Any such application must be made by no later than 3 April 2020 (this represents a period of six weeks beginning with the day after the date on which the Local Plan was adopted).
