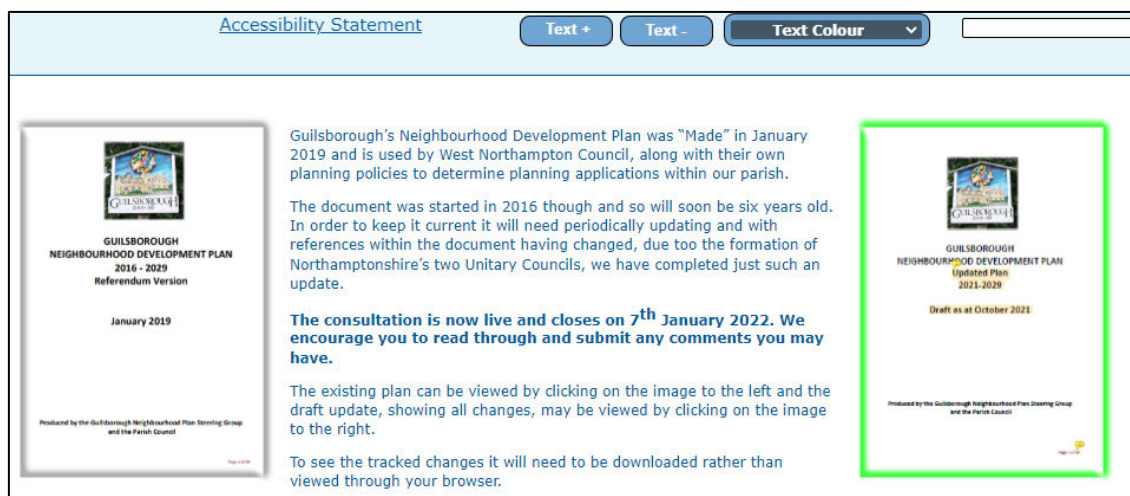
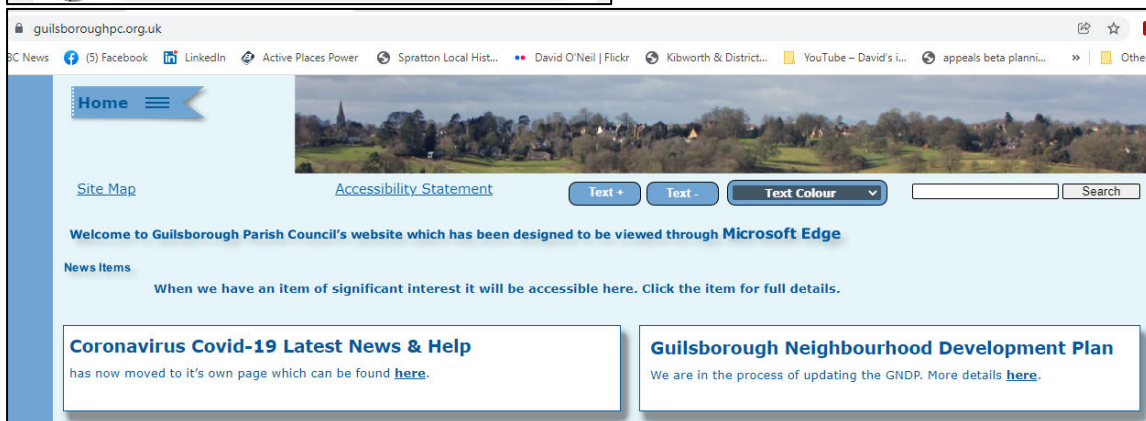
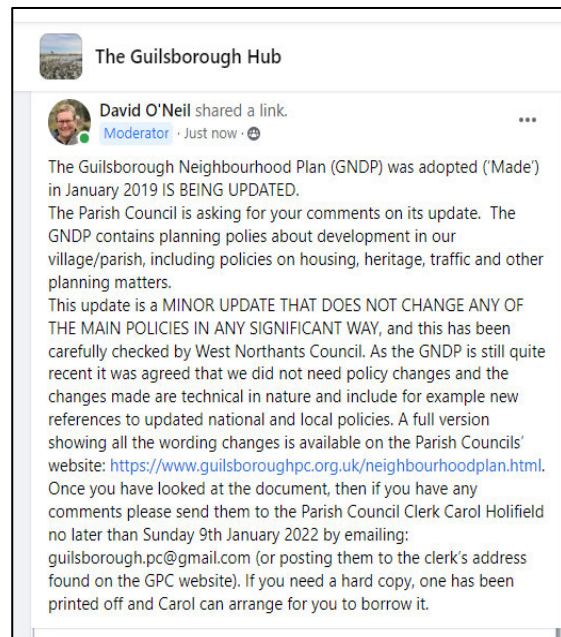


GNDP Consultation: November/December 2021

The Updated Draft Neighbourhood Plan was put up on the main village website 'The Guilsborough Hub' (461 members who live in Guilsborough) and on the Parish Council website, on the 27th November 2021. It was reposted on the Hub on the 14th December 2021. It was also posted on the two Village Notice Boards.



The Guilsborough Neighbourhood Plan (GNDP) was adopted ('Made') in January 2019 IS BEING UPDATED.

GUILSBOROUGH NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN UPDATE CONSULTATION

The Parish Council is asking for your comments on the update of the Guilsborough Neighbourhood Development Plan. The GNDP contains planning policies about development in our village/parish, including policies on housing, heritage, traffic and other planning matters.

This update is a MINOR UPDATE THAT DOES NOT CHANGE ANY OF THE MAIN POLICIES IN ANY SIGNIFICANT WAY, and this has been carefully checked by West Northants Council. As the GNDP is still quite recent it was agreed that we did not need policy changes and the changes made are technical in nature and include for example new references to updated national and local policies.
