Location/Suitability	Good transport links. Good public transport bus service runs hourly and approximately 200yds from polling station. The Hall is visible from the main road (A361) and illuminated at night.

Access	Disabled access is via a gentle upwards sloping ramp with hand rail. Inside we have double swing doors, easy to open. Disabled toilet facilities in Main Hall area and in Meeting Room (for second polling booth), both fitted with alarms. Easy to manoeuvre in either location.
